Sole Hope provides weekly clinics in Uganda, focusing on and fighting a parasite called Jiggers. These sand fleas burrow into bare feet causing debilitating issues. Sole Hope's medical teams provide jigger removal, treatment, preventive education, and a pair of shoes for each person they treat to help fight reinfection.

Bring a pair of old denim jeans (not stretchy) to be cut up and used for shoe pattern pieces. They can be any color. We will only use the legs so you can cut off the top of the jeans to make them lighter. Campers should NOT pack the jeans in their suitcases. They should bring them to be collected at the busing location PRIOR to loading the buses.
